Gift Aid Regulations:-

1. Under Gift Aid regulations you are not allowed to give a gift via a charity, to a close relative. ("Close relative" means children, grandchildren, parents, grandparents, siblings or the spouses of any of these.)
2. You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that NLCC will reclaim on your donations in each tax year.
3. Under UK tax laws, husbands and wives are taxed separately and we therefore cannot accept a 'joint' Gift Aid Declaration. Each person who wishes to give under the Gift Aid Scheme must complete a separate Gift Aid Declaration.
4. If your donation is in the form of a cheque from a joint bank account, then the person signing the cheque must be the person who has completed the Gift Aid Declaration in order for NLCC to reclaim the tax on your donation.
5. As your declaration covers donations in the future:
 - Please notify the Church Treasurer if you change your name or address while the declaration is still in force.
 - You may cancel your declaration at any time by notifying the Church Treasurer – we will then make no further tax reclaims on donations you make on or after the date of cancellation or such later date as you specify.
6. If, in the future, your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and/or capital gains equal to that reclaimed by NLCC, you should cancel your declaration (see note 2).

If you pay tax at the higher rate, you can reclaim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
